“Compliance can be really burdensome, but making the first steps towards compliance doesn’t require a whole overhaul of everything you’re doing,” said Bailey. “You can begin by evaluating your current data practices across the organization, revising your privacy policy and website terms of use as needed, updating your breach notification procedure if necessary, and adding an opt-in consent to data retention.”
